DSLA Final Research Reading

The 68-judgment week shows a Supreme Court handling a mixed but institutionally important docket. On the public-law side, the Court dealt with electoral rolls, online gaming, environmental enforcement and public land regularisation. On the regulatory side, it addressed GST, competition, securities, customs and excise questions. Meanwhile, the criminal docket focused on evidence quality, sentence proportionality, police abuse, corruption, fair-trial limits, matrimonial cruelty and road accident negligence.

For DSLA's internal research use, this week should be treated as a high-precedent and high-practical-value week. Several judgments deserve separate case notes because they affect litigation strategy, trial practice, regulatory compliance and public-law remedies.
